Subject: Report on Audit of Independent Activity Funds for the Period
October 1, 2020, through February 28, 2022

Independent Activity Funds (IAFs) of Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) are established to promote the general welfare, education, and morale of students, as well as to finance the recognized extracurricular activities of the student body. School principals are the fiduciary agents for the IAFs charged with determining the manner in which funds are raised and expended for activities such as field trips, admission events, and fund-raisers. They are responsible for ensuring that the IAFs are administered in accordance with Board of Education policies and MCPS regulations and procedures.

The IAF audits are conducted regularly to evaluate compliance with policies, regulations, and procedures, and to review processes for continuous improvement. Generally accepted audit procedures guide the work of the auditors who examine samples of the IAF records and financial accounts selected from documentation of various activities to verify their accuracy, as well as to assess the effectiveness of financial control procedures. An IAF audit does not review every transaction or school activity, but seeks to provide reasonable assurance that any significant errors or omissions in the financial records are detected.

At our April 19, 2022, meeting with you, and Mrs. Monique N. Riddick, school business administrator, we noted that in our report dated January 15, 2021, there were no conditions that required corrective action, and we continue to note no conditions that require corrective action. Although we did discuss and resolve a few minor matters, we are pleased to report that we found no weaknesses that require your attention. Records compiled and maintained by your financial team were orderly and in compliance with MCPS requirements and that contributed significantly to the prompt completion of this audit. We would like to recognize that this is the fourth consecutive audit with no reportable findings. No response to this report is required.
